## Pick up an I.D. for 2011-2012 Teen Dances & Lounge

### Teen Program Identification

Join in on the fun and get your Teen ID today! Your Teen ID gives you access to the teen lounge after school program, Teen Dances at the Weber Center and summer games at Oakton Park (teen dances are an additional fee). Teen ID's can be purchased at any park district facility. A valid form of school identification (below) is required to purchase a Teen ID. Teen ID's must be purchased by a parent. Teen ID's for the 2011-2012 school year can be purchased beginning June 8.

### Valid Forms of Identification

**YOU MUST** show one of these forms of identification to obtain a teen ID

- School picture ID card
- Report card with grade level
- Any school schedule or letter from school with name and grade level.

### Residents

Teen ID's are available for youth grades 6-8 who attend a Village of Skokie school or reside in the Village of Skokie.:

- \$6 - 1 year pass
- \$10 - 2 year pass (6th and 7th graders only)
- \$15 - 3 year pass (6th graders only)

### Non-Residents

Annual non-resident IDs are \$11. To obtain a Non-resident ID, you **MUST** show one valid form of identification (as defined above).

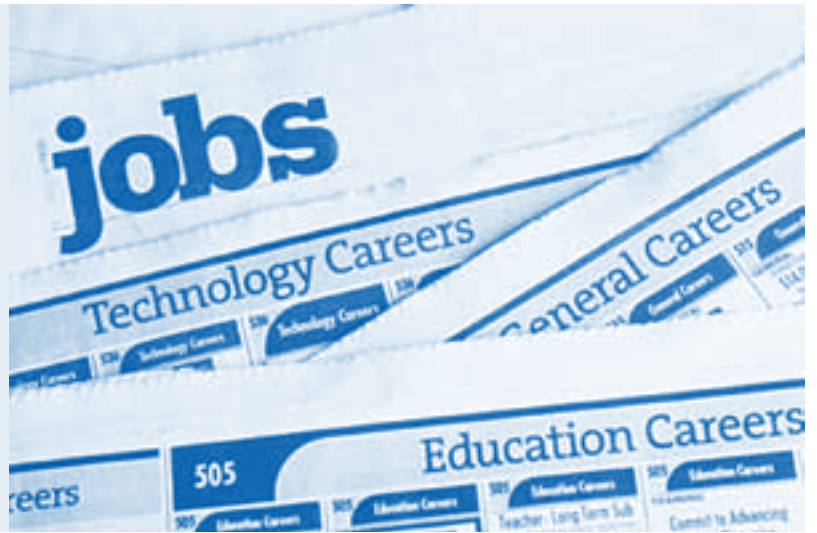
